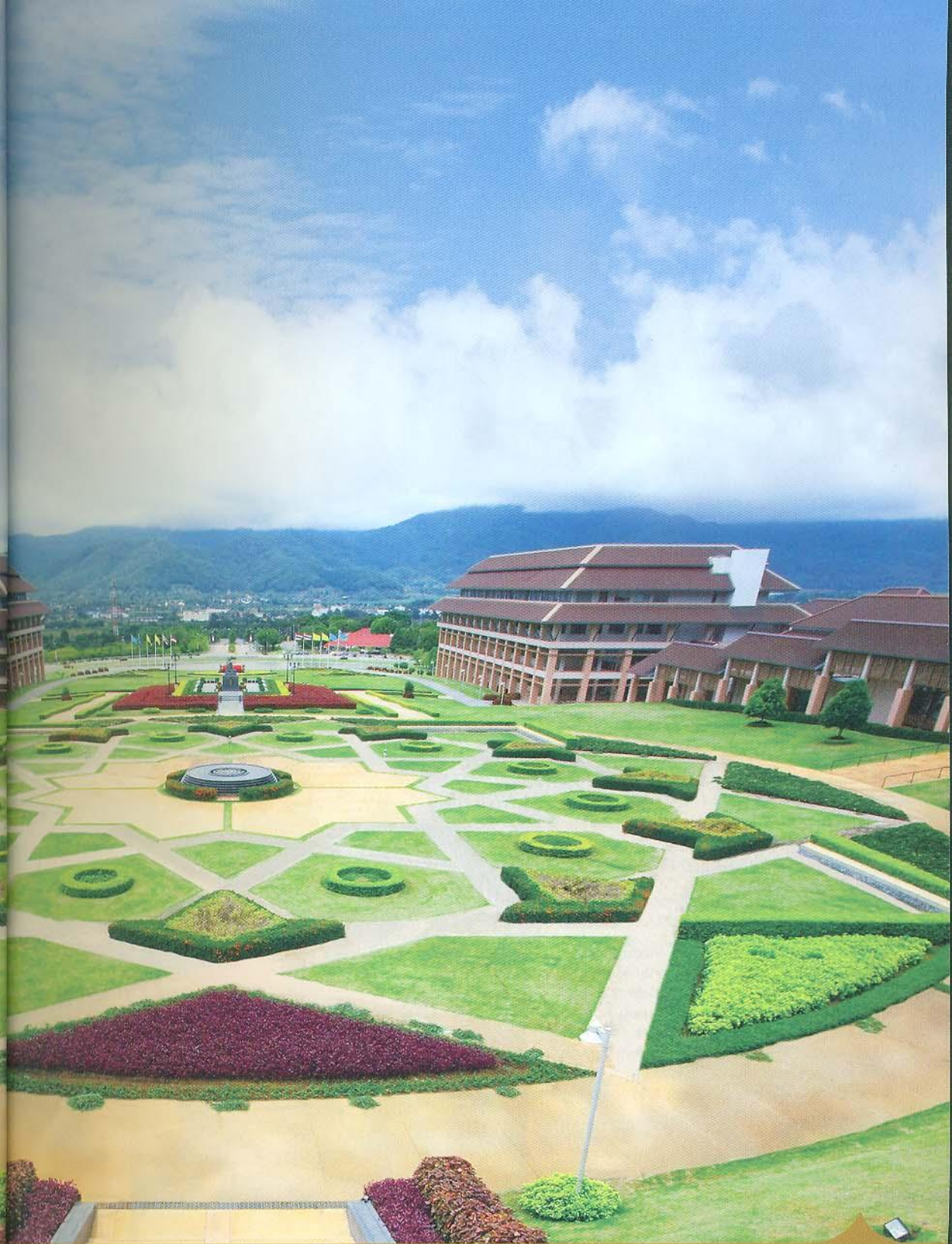
GENERAL INFORMATION

HISTORY OF MAE FAH LUANG UNIVERSITY

Mae Fah Luang University (MFU) was established as an autonomous public institution, under the Royal Charter, in 1988, with generous financial support from the Royal Thai Government. The University was established to meet the needs of people in the North of Thailand, and to commemorate the gracious contribution of the King's Mother, Her Royal Highness Princess Srinagarindra, lovingly known to her subjects as "Mae Fah Luang." From its inaugural class of 64 students in 1998, MFU has become Thailand's fastest growing post-secondary institution with an enrollment of more than 8,200 students in 2010. After just 11 years of operation, it is already well-known for its high quality teaching, research, and service to the people of the North, and to the country.

The campus consists of a large complex of modern, state-of-the-art buildings spanning more than 800 hectares. The campus is located in a spectacular setting of mountains and trees, conducive to teaching and learning in a clean, inviting environment. As the University has been growing, construction of a new lecture building, social research center and staff residence has been implemented. Established to serve as both a regional and a national university, MFU also provides high-quality education services and resources for the neighboring countries of the Greater Mekong Sub-region (GMS), and reaches out to all of Southeast Asia.

UNIVERSITY SYMBOLIC COLORS

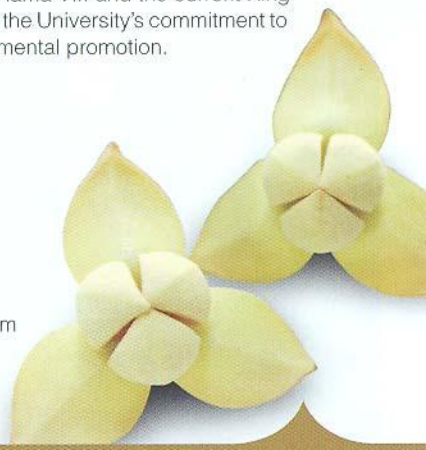
The University symbolic colors are red and gold.

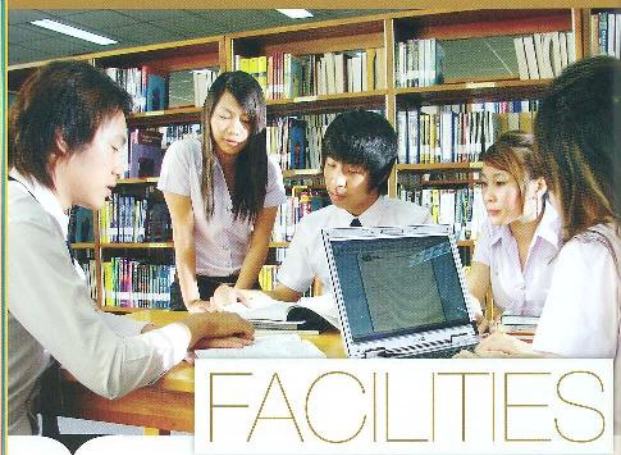
School of Cosmetic Science

About the School of Cosmetic Science

School of Cosmetic Science was established in January 2005. The School offers study programs at the B.Sc. and M.Sc. levels. Both curricula have been designed to provide fundamental and advanced knowledge as well as skills in cosmetic science for students wishing to pursue their careers in the cosmetic industry. As a matter of fact, our School is the first institution offering this kind of study program in Thailand and hence an ideal place for students and people who are interested in pursuing their study in this field.

Programs

At present, the Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) and Master of Science (M.Sc.) degrees are offered by the School of Cosmetic Science. The course structure consists of a comprehensive series of fundamental science subjects and advanced courses in cosmetic science and relevant fields. In addition, the M.Sc. program (by research only) is available for well-trained graduates.

ACADEMIC SUPPORTING SERVICE CENTERS

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES

The Center for Information Technology Services at Mae Fah Luan University provides computing facilities and integrated instruction methods for the use of IT in degree programs. Computer sites are located around the campus and offer access to a range of networked software packages, database systems, internet accessibility, teleconference systems, and computer-aided learning materials. These facilities are linked to printers, plotters, and scanners, and are designed to meet the needs of each school, including language laboratories. Moreover, the Local Area Networks (LAN), which spans the campus and provides access to other services on the web, is an excellent way to gain information from around the world. The education areas currently have a wireless capability.

LIBRARY AND LEARNING RESOURCES CENTER

The Center for Learning Resources and Educational Media has an extensive collection of books, E-books, periodicals, government publications, statistical and reference sources, maps, and audio-visual materials. A wide range of electronic library services is also provided. The library website "Library Online" enables computer-enabled information about library services and resources.

SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL INSTRUMENTS CENTER

The Center for Scientific and Technological Instruments provides equipment for teaching, training, and research to school and public. All laboratories are well-equipped with modern and sophisticated instruments.



INTERNATIONAL ADMISSIONS

Admission Requirements

WPU welcomes applications from students all around the world. International students can apply anytime throughout the year.

Students from all accredited colleges and universities are invited to submit their official transcripts for credit transfer to WPU.

Deadline of the application for the first semester (September to November): April 30

Deadline of the application for the second semester (November to March): September 30

Please note: Students who do not meet the English proficiency requirement have to take the English Foundation Course during the 1st Semester.

1. Bachelor Degree Programs

Admission Requirements for Bachelor Degree Programs

Applicants must hold High School Certificate or equivalent to grade 12, as confirmed by the Ministry of Education, or as conforming to other WPU criteria.

Documents Required with an Application:

- (1) A photocopy of an officially certified High School Certificate or equivalent, with the original to follow.
- (2) A photocopy of transcripts, with the original to follow.
- (3) A photocopy of identity card or passport, with the original to be presented upon registration.
- (4) One of 2.5 x 3 cm, photograph (6 mm x 4 mm).
- (5) Application Fee 300 Baht.

2. Master Degree Programs

Admission Requirements for Master Degree Programs

- (1) Applicants must have Bachelor Degree in related field from an accredited university with GPA of 2.5 or above.
