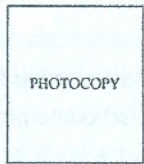

Scholarship

"The university will not let good students-resign because of financial hardship" is the policy of the Mae Fah Luang University. The university provides various types of scholarship to our students needing financial supports. Each year there are variety of the scholarships from government divisions, private enterprises and individuals. Moreover, the university also arranges fundraising for this cause as well.

Students wishing to obtain the funds must do the following:

1. Fill out the form at the Scholarship Section, Division of Student Development Affairs.
2. Prepare all documents.
3. Submit the form in person at the Scholarship Department, Division of Student Development Affairs according to the schedule provided.

Conditions and Commitments to the University

1. Scholastic students of Mae Fah Luang University should consistently volunteer to work with all divisions in the university.
2. Students should support the divisions or the schools that they work for. Their jobs may include filing, collecting data or what needed to be done.

Code of conduct for Scholastic Student Receiving The MFU Scholarship

1. Report to the scholarship division and after receiving the fund, deposit in the jointed bank account between the recipient and the advisor.
2. Pay attention in class.
3. Spend the scholarship wisely.
4. Follow the university rules and be a role model for other students.
5. Participate in university activities at least 10 times per an academic year.
6. Write the letters of gratitude, curriculum vitae, or other to the scholarship providers. It is recommended that all scholastic students should send greetings cards to scholarship providers as well.
7. Volunteer to do some goodwill activities at least 60 hours per semester and report to the Scholarship section, Division of Students Affairs monthly.
8. Submit the grade report to the Division of Students Affairs every semester.
9. Keep record of how the fund is spent and send the report to the division.
10. Follow up the announcement of the scholarship and that of the university consistently.
11. Scholastic students who misbehave or spend the grant inappropriately will be ineligible for scholarship or the grant will be deducted.
