- Module 1: Advanced Cosmetic Science for Skin
- Module 2: Advanced Cosmetic Science for Hair and Nail
- Module 3: Advanced Cosmetic Science for Aromatherapy and Spa
- Module 4: Advanced Cosmetic Science for Color and Make-up

The student will certify the Certificate of each module. Those who finish the major compulsory courses and IS will graduate the M.Sc. Program in Cosmetic Science.

Admission Requirements

- For the B.Sc. degree, applicants must complete the higher secondary school level (Matthayom 6 or equivalent) in a science program.
- For the M.Sc. program (Plan A), applicants should have graduated or be expecting to graduate from an accredited college or university with a degree in an allied with the GPA of at least 2.5 (on 1 - 4 scale).
- For those with a lower GPA or a non-related B.Sc. degree but well-trained and experienced in cosmetic industry are recommended to apply for the M.Sc. (Plan B).

(Cosmetic Science)

The degree has been designed to develop knowledge background, and professional skill in Cosmetic Science. Suitable for those students wishing to pursue their careers in the cosmetic





M.Sc. (Cosmetic Science)

There are two study plans as follow: * Plan A (Type I), the graduate student



carrying out activities in the field of formulation, production, control, marketing and technical scientific information related to the cosmetic world. In addition, theoretical and practical lessons will give qualified specific training on cosmetic products, as This plan consists of major compulsory, major elective and thesis courses.

* Plan A (Type II) program is offered to those graduates who wish to acquire a deeper scientific knowledge in research and development, as well as formulation of cosmetic products. The evaluation depends exclusively on research performance and the dissertation. Graduates are expected to participate in an academic seminar and conference for their research presentation. This plan is by research only. * Plan B (Thai Language) is launched for those graduates who are well trained and experienced in the cosmetic business and wish to concentrate on activities in the cosmetic business area. This plan consists of major compulsory courses, which are separated into four modules as shown below and
