Registration

The registration date for each academic year is officially announced at www.mfu.ac.th

Required Documents

- Two 1-inch color photographs while dressed in proper student uniform.
- Two copies of passport (student to verify each copy with signature).
- Two copies of name change certificate (student to verify each copy with signature).
- Two copies of high school or diploma certificate (student to verify each copy with signature).
- Two copies of transcript (student to verify each copy with signature).

Step 1: Payment

- Fill out a yellow registration form and prepare the documents listed above.
- Present documents and tuition fees to the Division of Registrar during the registration period.
- 3. Receive a tuition fee receipt.
- Receive your password to access the Online Course Registration Website.

Step 2: Student ID Card

Upon registration, the Division of Registrar will help students to obtain a Student ID card. The ID card, which is issued by the Bank of Ayudhya, can also be used as an ATM card and Visa Electron. Please allow 3 weeks for it to be processed. Students may have to inquire at the Bank of Ayudhya (D1 building) as to when it is ready, and then pick it up in person.

Step 3: Open a bank account

- Pick up a bank form at the Division of Registrar and fill it out. Prepare the documents listed below.
 - > A copy of passport (student to verify the copy)
 - A copy of visa (student to verify the copy)
 - > A 1-inch color photograph with proper student uniform
 - > A copy of MFU acceptance letter
- Electron ID fee of THB 155.
- The minimum THB 100 deposit needed to open an account.

Note. If your receipt is lost, go to the police station and receive the proper form. Next go to the accounting department to get a copy of the receipt.

Note: Please wear your student uniform every time you visit a University office.

Student dormitories

The University has increased its accommodation capacity and offers up to 5,000 beds in 16 dormitory buildings for students.
