



Chiang Rai City

Chiang Rai is the northernmost province of Thailand, with a population of about 1.3 million. It is one of the most beautiful cities in Thailand and in the Greater Mekong Sub-region. Mae Fah Luang University is located at the foot of a spectacular range of mountains. It is only 8 kilometers from downtown Chiang Rai, and 17 Kilometers from Chiang Rai International Ariport and transportation is readily available. Your life in Chiang Rai can be as lively as you want it to be, with a wide variety of sight-seeing opportunities and many Thai restaurants. The province's tourist attractions have much to offer: Doi Tung, Phu Chee Fah, Mae Salong, Golden Triangle, textile and wood carving villages, museums, art galleries, and temples, all reflect the unique culture of northern Thailand, called Lanna.

Travel and Weather

Chiang Rai is easily accessible from Bangkok. Flights from Bangkok are just over 1 hour away, with several low-cost airlines flying to and from other popular destinations and seaside resorts. Public transportation is available for traveling between downtown Chiang Rai and the University, as well as for excursions to tourist attractions in and around the surrounding provinces.

The comfortably cool nights of summer, in contrast to the days and lower winter temperature from October to March, attract many visitors to Chiang Rai. The City has numerous modern amenities and yet retains its oldworld beauty, charm, and traditions.



The campus is located on a hill side at the foot of a range of spectacular mountains. The Central Administration Building and Office of the President, which is constructed in a spacious northern architectural style, amidst flower gardens and man-made lakes, forms the focal point for the campus. Lan Dao Garden is carefully designed to portray stars in front of the classroom buildings to direct attention to the central administration building.

In response to rapidly increasing student numbers, the University has increased its accommodation capacity and offers up to 5,000 beds in 16 dormitory buildings for students. An International student's dormitory is also available. The University's attractive residence are just a ten minute walk from the main building. All rooms are fully equipped with basic facilities and internet access. Each dormitory contains a common room, TV room with cable, study room, and recreational area. Students have their own privacy, within a safe, friendly, and lively learning environment.











Mae Fah Luang University's reputation for its "University in the park" environment and excellent academic facilities has attracted numerous visitors from many countries. This has led to mutual cooperation, which encourage the rapidly increasing numbers of international students since 2004.

From the early enquiry stage, assisting with application procedures. The international student advisor provides guidance and assistance on matters such as immigration and travel.

In additional, the Division of International Affairs contains a wealth of information for students and faculty members who require information about universities and study opportunities around the world. The Division also administers the University's Academic Collaboration Agreements and maintains close contact with many international colleges and university abroad, as well as other in-country institutions.

The University provides a variety of English language courses and support services, both in preparing for and during the international students' period of study.

Academic Support and Services Centers

Information Technology Services Centers

The Center for Information Technology Services at Mae Fah Luang University provides computing facilities and integrated instruction methods for the use of IT in degree programs. Computer sites are located around the campus and offer access to a range of networked software packages, database systems, internet accessibility, teleconference systems, and computer-aided learning materials.

These facilities are linked to printers, plotters, and scanners, and are designed to meet the needs of each school, including language laboratories. Moreover, the Local Area Network (LAN), which covers the campus and provides access to other worldwide networks, is an excellent way to gain information from around the world. The Educational Areas currently have a wireless capability.

Library and Learning Resources Center

The Center for Learning Resources and Educational Media has an extensive collection of books, e-books, periodicals, government publications, statistical and reference sources, maps, and audio-visual materials. A wide range of electronic library services is also provided. The library website, library online, contains comprehensive information about library services and resources.

Scientific and Technological Instrument Center

The Center for Scientific and Technological Instruments provides equipment for teaching, training, and research to Schools and public. All laboratories are well-equipped with modern and sophisticated instruments.







Center for Academic Services

The Center for Academic Services was established primarily to support quality education and to disseminate new-found knowledge to the public for application, to strengthen the community and contribute to the social and economic development of the country. The Center for Academic Services' main mission is to organize academic activities, such as conferences and training programs, seeking external customers in order to bring in revenue and serving as the University's outlet, providing academic and research services to external organizations.

Resources Centers

The Sirindhorn Chinese Language and Culture Center

The Sirindhorn Chinese Language and Culture Center provides state-of-theart facilities for Chinese language and culture studies. The building is spectacularly designed in typical Suzhou architecture, and built with a generous grant from the government of the People's Republic of China (PRC).

There are exhibition halls with Chinese artifacts and paintings, computer laboratories equipped with multi-media tools, libraries with Chinese textbooks, references, periodicals and maps. The Sirindhorn Chinese Language and Culture Center is the only one of its kind supported by the People's Republic of China outside China.

The French-Upper Mekong Sub-region Academic Cooperation Center

The French-Upper Mekong Sub-region Academic Cooperation Center at Mae Fah Luang University is a center of knowledge transfer between France, Thailand, and other GMS countries. The center has a mission to engage in academic cooperation between France and Thailand in the area of science, social science, technology, language and culture, and to exchange knowledge and experience between France and Thailand.

Mae Fah Luang University <u>Business Incubator (MFUBI)</u>

Mae Fah Luang University Business Incubator (MFUBI) was among the first twelve universities selected to be a pilot university business incubator to promote entrepreneurship across the university. The Thailand University Business Incubator Project was initiated and is financially supported by the Bureau of Student Development, Commission on Higher Education, Ministry of Education, aiming to create a nurturing environment for faculty, students, graduates, staff, and other entrepreneurs to incubate commercially viable ideas into products or services.

MFUBI focuses on supporting and nurturing such new start-up companies at all stages of development. Its goal is to raise awareness of entrepreneurship and provide practical business development services to students and graduates who might consider self employment as a future career. It provides space, access to resources, business assistance, and professional services to start-up businesses to facilitate growth and development during their critical early existence and to enable them to survive their early stages of growth and to enhance their company's long-term success and sustainability. Furthermore, it hopes to be a university technology transfer outlet to provide technology support services.

Other Facilities

The campus boasts a modern gymnasium, sports fields, a post office, banks and ATMs, a book center, food centers, a health center and zero emission electronic (EVT) transportation.

Admission Requirements

MFU welcomes applications from students all around the world.

Students from all accredited colleges and universities are invited to submit their official transcripts for credit's transfer to MFU.

1. Bachelor's Degree Programs

Admission Requirements for Bachelor Degree Programs

Applicants must hold High School Certificate certified or equivalent to grade 12, as certified by the Ministry of Education, or as conforming to other MFU criteria.

Documents Required with an Application:

- (1) A photocopy of an officially certified of High School Certificate or equivalent, with the original to follow
- (2) A photocopy of transcripts, with the original to follow
- (3) A photocopy of identity card or passport, with the original to be presented at registration
- (4) Four recent 2.5 x 3 cm. photographs (not more than 6 months old)





2. Master's Degree Programs

Admission Requirements for Master's Degree Programs

- (1) Applicants must have a Bachelor's Degree in the same or a related field from an accredited university with GPA of 2.5 or above.
- (2) If GPA is below 2.5, applicants must have GPA of the core courses at 2.75 or above, or 1 year working experience in a related field with a recommendation letter from an employer.
- (3) Never have been disqualified by any institution.

Documents Required with an Application:

- (1) A photocopy of an officially certified Bachelor's degree
- (2) A photocopy of transcripts, with the original to follow
- (3) A photocopy of identity card or passport, with the original to be presented at registration.
- (4) Four recent 2.5 x 3 cm. photographs (not more than 6 months old)

3. Doctoral Degree Programs

Admission Requirements for Doctoral Degree Programs

- (1) Applicants must have either a Master's Degree or equivalent from an accredited university or a Bachelor's Degree (Honors) in a related field, with GPA of 3.25.
- (2) For research-focused programs, applicants must have experience in conducting research or writing a dissertation in a related field, and have a publication of the research or dissertation in an acceptable journal.
- (3) Never have been disqualified by any institution.

Documents Required with an Application:

- (1) A photocopy of an officially -certified Master's Degree or Bachelor's Degree (Honors)
- (2) A photocopy of transcripts, with the original to follow
- (3) A photocopy of identity card or passport, with the original to be presented at registration
- (4) Four recent 2.5 x 3 cm. photographs (not more than 6 months old)
