MFU Admission Requirements

MASTER'S PROGRAMMES

- Applicants for master's programmes must have graduated from a curriculum that is accredited by the Ministry of Education or the university council.
 Furthermore, the qualifications of applicants must meet the requirements set by each programme.
- Applicants for each master's programmes must have a bachelor's degree or equivalent.
- The English proficiency requirement depends on the programme applicants are applying for.

DOCTORAL PROGRAMMES

- Applicants must have graduated from a curriculum that is accredited by the Ministry of Education or the university council. Furthermore, the qualifications of applicants must meet the requirements set by each programme.
- Applicants for doctoral programmes must have a master's degree or equivalent.
- Applicants for doctoral programmes must have a bachelor's degree with honours or equivalent.
- Applicants for doctoral programmes must submit their English proficiency test results according to the following criteria:



English Proficiency Test	Test Score
TOEFL (IBT)	72
TOEFL (ITP)	543
IELTS	6
CU-TEP	70
MFU-TEP (B2)	60

The test results must not be older than 2 years from the date of the exam. In the case that any curriculum has set higher scores, the criteria by the programme admission shall be used.

- In case that applicants do not have English proficiency test results or have the results lower than the criteria, they will be accepted to study in the programme under certain conditions.
- They have to submit English proficiency test results mentioned in the table above within the first semester of their study or they have to enroll and pass the "Academic English for graduate Studies 1" course; otherwise it will be considered that they have not passed the admission process and their student status will be revoked.
- Applicants are allowed to submit the result of the "Academic English for graduate Studies 1" course (S grade) that is no older than two years since an announcement of the grade result.



Graduation Conditions

• The students who are eligible to graduate must have an English proficiency level that corresponds to the set requirement for graduate students as listed in the MFU announcement entitled "English Proficiency Test Requirements for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University." This requirement is also set in accordance with Mae Fah Luang University's Regulations on Graduate Studies 2017.

Other Conditions

- The university will not refund the application fee and the tuition fee regardless of any circumstances.
- Once the applicants have submitted the application form, it means that they
 have already studied and verified their qualifications. If it is found later that
 the applicants are disqualified, they will not be eligible for the admission
 examination.

MFU-TEP (The Test of English Proficiency)

- MFU-TEP will be held 3-5 times a year of which the exact dates will be announced by School of Liberal Arts, MFU.
- MFU-TEP consists of 4 parts including: Listening; Spoken expression; Grammar and Written Expression; and Reading.
- Payment of 1,000 THB should be made either by:
 - Cash at Finance and Accounting Division, MFU



Step 2: Submit Application Form

Step 3: Receive Information

- E-mail confirmation will be received in approximately 4 weeks.
- An interview can be held by telephone or Skype video call. Other documents may be required; in this case, further notification will be sent.
- A successful interview will be followed by an official acceptance letter with the necessary visa request documents and acceptance package.

Step 4: Arrive at the MFU Campus

- Inform the Global Relations Division of your arrival details for pickup services from the Mae Fah Luang Chiang Rai International Airport or Chiang Rai Bus Station (1 week in advance).
- International students are guaranteed dormitory rooms on campus.

Step 5: Register for Classes

- Submit original copies of all necessary documents to the Registrar Division.
- Full fees must be paid in Thai Baht (THB) currency.
