Recording Personal Information and Uploading Documents

During 26 Dec 2022 - 10 Jan 2023, all new students have to fill out personal information and upload documents onto the online new student data record system at:

The new student data record system consists of five sections:

1. Verifying personal email address
2. Filling out student biography and uploading documents and photo and uploading the completed consent form for student and parents
3. Filling out the survey (Postgraduate students and exchange students can skip this section.)
4. Making tuition fee payment
5. Verifying educational qualification

Caution: We recommend that you fill out information and upload documents using Google's Chrome browser on computer or laptop only. Mobile browsers are not supported.

Payment

There are three options for students to choose:

1.	Credit card (Visa / Master/JCB)
2.	Union Pay
3.	International Remittance (International Transfer)

Remarks:

1. You have to be responsible for a service charge fee at 2.5% including VAT in case you chose the first and second payment option.

2. If you want to pay using the third option, you need to be responsible for a service charge fee collected by both the overseas bank and Thai bank.

3. If you want to pay using the third option, you need to submit a proof of payment and inform your name and student ID to interadmission@mfu.ac.th and finrev.finance@mfu.ac.th for officer's reference. ***see MFU bank account information on page No. 6**

4. You can print out a receipt from the Educational Service System (REG) at the "Print receipt" menu after you complete all sections in the new student data record system.

Caution:

Please do not process "Print Receipt" through a mobile phone because once you click the "Print" button, it means the original official receipt is printed. The second printing onwards will be a copy of the original receipt!

Dormitory Information and Recommended Items

General Information:

Mae Fah Luang University has increased its accommodation capacity and offers almost 6,000 beds in 18 furnished dormitory building for students. There are 14 female dormitory buildings with 4,497 beds and 4 male dormitory buildings with 1,368 beds. Students' residences are just a ten-minute walk from the main buildings. Students have privacy within a safe, friendly and lively learning environment. All first year Bachelor's students are required to live on campus, which encourages students to develop their social skills through living together, learning together and helping one another. Assignments to any of the dormitories are made on a random basis. All students are required to submit dormitory forms, which will be provided upon move-in.

- 4,000 - 6,000 THB per person per semester (4 person shared room).
- 5,500 - 8,000 THB per person per semester (3 person shared room, limited rooms are available).
- Students are responsible for electrical and water bills.

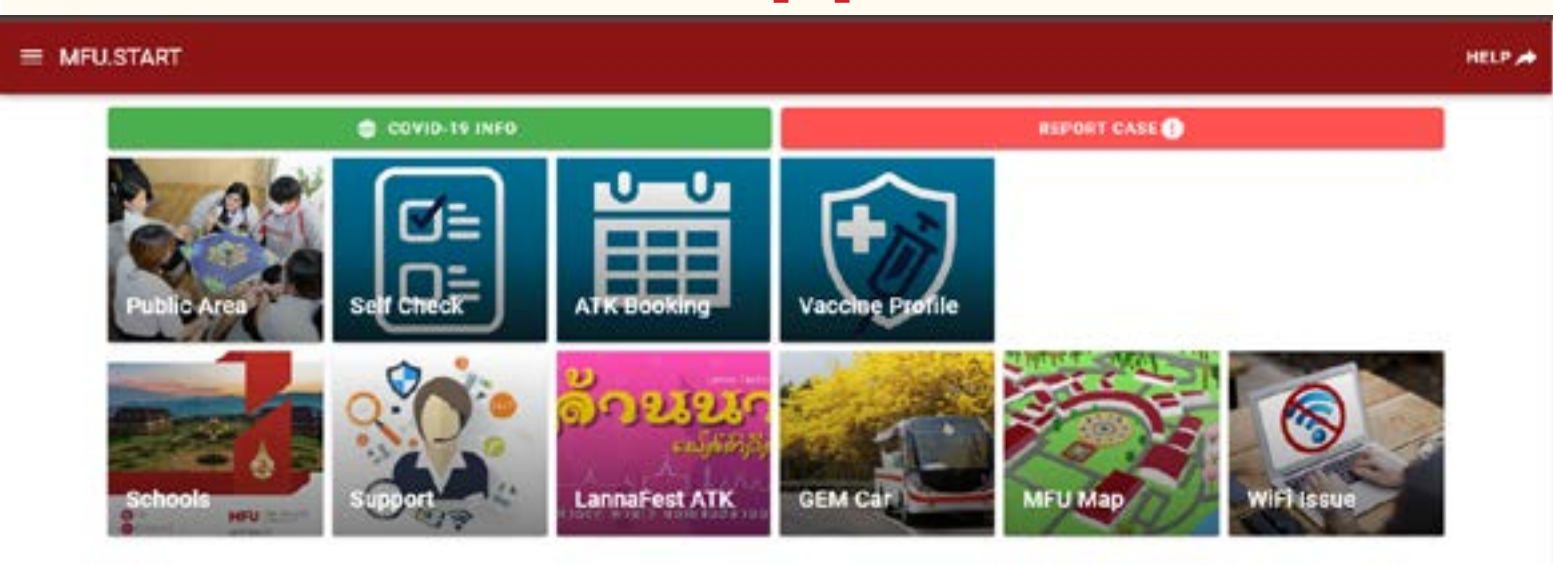

Student Uniform

Students who are registered at Undergraduate level are required to wear university uniforms in strict accordance with the university policy. The uniform requirements are specified below:

Male

A white long-sleeved shirt, navy/black trousers; a black leather belt with MFU buckle; black leather shoes; a blue necktie with the university pin.

Female

A short-sleeved white standard female uniform blouse with a fold line at the back and engraved MFU buttons; the blouse must be tucked into a standard female university black skirt, which must be long enough to cover the knees. Both the skirt and the blouse must not be too tight. The skirt must be worn with a suede brown university belt with an engraved MFU belt buckle. First years must wear plain white sports shoes with white ankle-length socks; second year students and above must wear standard black leather uniform shoes. The university pin must be clasped on the right hand side of the shirt at chest level.

Muslim

Muslim students are required to wear a long pleated skirt with a long sleeve shirt and white veil without accessories.

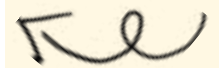

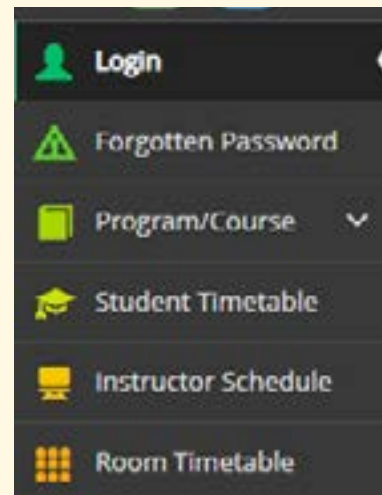

Once you have finished filling out the new student data record system, the Registrar Division will forward your information to the Bangkok bank and the bank will process it.

Once the student card and bankbook are ready, the Registrar Division will announce on their website <https://reg.mfu.ac.th> and Facebook page [Registrar@MFU](https://www.facebook.com/Registrar@MFU). Then, you just present your passport to the Bangkok bank, MFU and take student card and a bank book there

***For those who cannot come to the campus, the bank will keep the card and bankbook for you. Once you have arrived at the campus, you can contact them with your passport, so don't worry.*

Remarks:

- This will be your student card as well as your ATM card. This bankbook will be an official Thai bank account for you while you are studying at MFU.

- Please keep this account activated. We recommend that you have the Bangkok Bank Application on your mobile, as it will be convenient for you when you have to pay any fees to MFU; it is free of charge and you can do it any time



Health Checkup

New bachelor's degree students are required to have a physical examination at the MFU Hospital (located on the campus).

Date and time for the health checkup will be announced soon.

There will be an electric shuttle bus service starting from 7.30 hrs. The bus leaves every 30 minutes and stops serving from 09.30 to 10.30 hrs. Please bring a copy of the tuition fee payment ref. or a picture of it on mobile to present to the hospital staff with your passport when you contact them.

Health Insurance

MFU provides 2 kinds of insurance for all international students: health insurance and accident insurance according to the MFU Announcement: [Guideline regarding the payment of health insurance for international students](#)

Although all International students are required to buy medical insurance with minimum coverage of \$ 10,000 covering COVID-19 to enter Thailand, we still recommend that you buy the health insurance we provide for you due to the following reasons.

- 1.** The health insurance company has signed a contract with most of the hospitals in Thailand, especially in Chiang Rai province. It means that you do not have to pay medical fees and there are staff members who take care of this matter closely.
- 2.** The maximum coverage for health insurance is 450,000 baht and the maximum coverage for accident insurance is 150,000 baht.
- 3.** In case that students are sick while they are in their home country, the student can send scanned files of original required documents to the staff and apply for the medical fee refund, based on the maximum coverage expenses in Thailand rate.
- 4.** The period of insurance MFU provided for students covers the whole academic year and is renewed for all enrolled students every year until they graduate.

MFU Character (MFU 333) Course

The MFU character has been designed to develop the identity of Mae Fah Luang University students and inspire them through the activities designed to foster the spirit of volunteerism, emotional intelligence, adaptability, team-working spirit and management skills upon moral and ethical foundations.

IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE "S" (SATISFACTORY) GRADE,

Students are required to meet a **minimum score of 90.**
