Admission Procedure for International Students (undergraduates)



1. Admission Requirements

A High School Certificate or equivalent to grade 12, with a good command of English.

### 2. Application Procedure

2.1 Submission of Application

Application can be submitted anytime from now

2.1.1. Apply by Mail

Simply download and print the application from www.mfu.ac.th, then send the completed form to Division of International Affairs, Mae Fah Luang University, Chiang Rai 57100, Thailand

2.1.2 Apply by E-mail

Simply download and attached the completed application form and required documents to inter@mfu.ac.th

2.1.2. Apply in Person

Simply download and print the appropriate application from www.mfu.ac.th, then bring the complete form to **Division** of International Affairs, Mae Fah Luang University, Tel 66-53-916-026

3. Supporting Documents

One copy of each of the following documents is required. All documents should be

in English or have a certified translation.

- 1. A recent 1-inch photograph (taken within 6 month period)
- 2. A copy of Passport
- 3. Certified Copy of High School Transcript
- 4. English Proficiency Score Report (TOEFL,

IELTS, etc.)

5. Financial Statement/Scholarship Documents (If

any)

### 5. Admission Procedure

### 5.1. Notification of Application Receipt and Status

Applicants will be notified of the receipt of their application and status by email or mail within 6 weeks.

### 5.2. Selection Procedure

 The selection criteria will be based on the admission documents, transcripts, grade point average or high school score.

# 5.3. Letter of Acceptance and Confirmation of Acceptance

For successful applicants, the notification of admission is done by e-mail or mail, within 6 weeks after the confirmation of acceptance.

 Non-Thai student will need the Letter of Acceptance from MFU in order to apply for a Non-Immigration ED (education) Visa from the Royal Thai Government (RTG) Embassy or Consulate office. Students should allow at least one month for this process.

### 6. Orientation Weeks.

Mae Fah Luang University provide three weeks orientation "How to Live and Learn in Campus". International Students who are accepted by Schools are recommended to attend this event.



### 7. Accommodation

First year students are required to stay in the dormitory and are requested to submit the application for the dormitory. The form can be downloaded from the www.mfu.ac.th

# 8. Transportation

Transportation off-campus.

- MFU provides the university van to pick up from Chiang Rai Airport / Bus station to MFU (free of charge)

- 6. Make a reservation for accommodation (The Office of Student Dormitory)

# **Uniform**

**Female**: a white, short-sleeved shirt with fold line at the back and MFU logo and engraved chrome buttons; a black skirt long enough to cover the knees; a brown leather belt with MFU buckle, white canvas shoes for 1<sup>st</sup> year students and black leather shoes for the others. The university pin must be clasped on the right hand side of the shirt at chest level.




Male: a white long-sleeved shirt, navy/black trousers; a black leather belt with MFU buckle; black leather shoes; a blue necktie.
