4. Certificate in Thai SPA

This one year residential program is tailored for the international students who seek practical knowledge in Spa business with an emphasis on Thai Spa therapy. The course is approved by the Thai Ministry of Public Health and is taught in English.

Entrance requirement : An ablility to understand English.

Basic subjects: Terminology, anatomy, physiology, psychology, ethics and law of consumer protection, bysiness and tourism management, communication and Information Technology, Thai history, culture and are.

Spa subjects: Histiry of Spa, characteristics and quality of natural spring water, introduction to alternative therapies, principles of care, holistic care, hydrotherapy, aromatherapy, principles of infection control and hygiene, management practice in Spa business.

Specialist Thai Spa subjects: Thai traditional herbal and massage therapy, Thai folk and Lanna-Thai remedies, Thai facial, body and foot massage and their benefits, hand, nail, skin and hair care, Thai exercise techniques for the maintenance of good health and mobility, Thai traditional dietary belief and practice, their health and nutritional benefits.

Bachelor of Applied Thai Traditional Medicine

(Applied Thai Traditional Medicine)

Entry requirement: Secondary school certificate (science stream)

First year: A foundation year of English, Thai and other language skills, mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology, social, science, psychology, medical termionlogy.

Second year: Anatomy, physiology, pathophysiology, nutrition, basic pharmacology, pharmacognosy, Thai traditional medicine, pharmacy, dispensary, massage and manipulation in theories and practice, basics in modern clinical medicine, advanced English language skills.

Third year: Continuation of Thai Traditional medicine at an adbanced level, Thai midwifery, modern clinical medicaine, surgery, ENT and obstetrics, radiology, microbiology, control of infection, ethics and law; clinical clerkship and practice in clinics.

Fourth year: A clinical and practical year with additional experiences in alternative medicines such as acupuncture, hydrotherapy Chinese and Indian Aryuravedic medicine.

Elective courses: A wide range of courses are available for both specialist subjects and free electices.

Career Prospects: Career Prospects of graduates are excellent in Government's hospitals and community clinics where Thai traditional medicine is popular and increasing in demand. They may work in the private sector, set up private practice, or be consultants to health related businesses such as in Spa resorts. Those with an academic leaning may choose to teach, study for postgraduate qualifications, or research.

2. Bachelor of Science (Health Care Service)
Entry requirement: secondary school certificate.

1st year: Foundation subjects, Medical terminology, Accidint Prevention and first aid, holistic care.

2nd year: Human function, pharmacognosy, child growth and development, Thai folk medicine, food and nutrition, health promotion, use of home drugs, caring principles for ADL (Activities of Daily Living).

3rd year: Human dysfunction, ealth care delivery systems, management of health care service, health assessment, health counselling, research in health science, Geriatric care, Geriatric care practice.

4th year: Care of the disabled, use of body devices, major elective subjects, practice and experience in care institutions at home and abroad.

Employment opportunities for graduates are in both state and private sectors, in the practical care of individuals in their own homes, nursing homes or other care institutions, in management of care provision, care homes, and tourism.

3. Diploma (Health Care Service)

This is a two year diploma course in Health Care Service. The course is run at Payathai 3 Hospital, Bangkok, under the academic Management of Mae Fah Luang University.
