

Medical Unit



This on-campus first-aid unit provides staff and students with preliminary medical treatment by a physician from a provincial hospital, who is stationed at this unit for two days a week; on the other days staff from the Student Development Division are available for counseling and issuing of first-aid medicine.

Mae Fah Luang University's auditoriums and conference halls, which are fully equipped with modern audiovisual facilities, can serve both the University and other organizations as venues for seminars, training programs, symposia and conferences.

Residence and Dormitory









In response to rapidly growing student numbers, the university has increased its accommodation capacity to as many as 5,000 beds in 16 dormitory buildings including are international dormitory. All rooms are equipped with basic facilities and internet access. Each dormitory building contains a common room, TV room with cable, study room, and recreational area. Students can have their own privacy, within a safe, friendly, and lively learning environment. In addition, a sports complex is provided on campus in response to a commitment to healthy living.

Admission Requirements

MFU welcomes applications from students all around the world.

Students from all accredited colleges and universities are invited to submit their official transcripts for credit transfer to MFU.

1. Bachelor's Degree Programs

Admission Requirements for Bachelor's Degree Programs

Applicants must hold High School Certificates, or degrees equivalent to grade 12, as certified by the Ministry of Education, or as conforming to other MFU criteria.

Documents Required for an Application:

- A photocopy of an official High School Certificate or equivalent, along with the original;
- (2) A photocopy of the transcript, along with the original;
- (3) A photocopy of the identity card or passport, along with the original, which is required upon registration;
- (4) Four 2.5 x 3 cm. photographs (no more than 6 months old).

2. Master Degree Programs

Admission Requirements for Master Degree Programs

- Applicants must have Bachelor Degree in related field from an accredited university with GPA of 2.5 or above.
- (2) If GPA is below 2.5, applicants must have GPA of the core course at 2.75 or above, or 1 year working experience in a related field with a recommendation letter from an employer.
- (3) Never been disqualified by any institution.

Documents Required with an Application:

- (1) A photocopy of an officially certified of Bachelor Degree
- (2) A photocopy of transcripts, with the original to follow
- (3) A photocopy of identity card or passport, with the original to be presented upon registration
- (4) Four 2.5 x 3 cm. photographs (6 months)

3. Doctoral Degree Programs

Admission Requirements for Doctoral Degree Programs

- (1) Applicants must have either Master's degree or equivalent from an accredited university or Bachelor's degree (Honors) in a related field, with GPA of 3.25.
- (2) For research-focused programs, applicants must have experience in conducting research or writing a dissertation in a related field, and have publication of the research or dissertation in an acceptable journal.
- (3) Never been disqualified by any institution.

Documents Required with an Application:

- (1) A photocopy of an officially certified of Master's degree or Bachelor's degree (Honors)
- (2) A photocopy of transcripts, with the original to follow
- (3) A photocopy of identity card or passport, with the original to be presented upon registration

By Bus

The coach ride from Bangkok to Chiang Rai is probably best made overnight since passengers can avail themselves of sleep prior to an early morning arrival. There are both air-conditioned and non-air-conditioned bus services from Bangkok's Northern Bus Terminal (Mochit 2 Bus Terminal) on Kamphaengphet 2 Road. The journey may take approximately 9-11 hours.
