History

Mae Fah Luang University was established as an autonomous public institution, under the Royal Charter in 1998, with generous financial support from the Royal Thai Government. The University was established to meet the needs of the people of the north of Thailand, and to commemorate the gracious contribution of the King's Mother. From its inaugural class of 64 students in 1998, Mae Fah Luang University has become Thailand's fastest growing post-secondary institution, with an enrollment expected to exceed 5000 students in 2005. After just six years of operation, it is already well-known for the high quality of its teaching, research and service to the people of the north, and to the country in general. The campus now consists of a large complex of modern, state-of-the-art buildings spanning more than 1000 acres. The campus is located in a spectacular setting of mountains and trees conducive to teaching and learning in a clean, inviting environment. As the university continues to grow, construction is on-going with a new residence and social building for international students, a large modern gymnasium, fitness facilities and outdoor sports fields.

Established to serve as both a regional and national university, MFLU also provides high quality educational services and resources to the neighboring countries of the Greater Mekong Sub-region (Lao PDR, Myanmar, Cambodia, Vietnam), and reaches out to all of Southeast Asia.

The philosophy of Mae Fah Luang University is embodied in the intention of the King's Mother to foster environmental quality and human resource development. In that regard, there is major focus on the promotion of environmental quality, the improvement of the quality of life for the disadvantaged through higher education, the building of human capacity, the on-going search for resourceful knowledge and the promotion and preservation of the culture and traditions of Thailand and the Greater Mekong Sub-region.

As an institution of higher education which meets international standards, the University aims to excel in selected academic areas, and has a strong commitment to excellence in teaching, research, academic services to society, technology adaptation and the promotion of arts and culture.

The Sirindhorn Chinese Language and Culture Center

The Sirindhorn Chinese Language and Culture Center provides state-of-the-art facilities for Chinese language and culture studies. The building is spectacularly designed in the typical Suzhou architecture, with a generous grant from the government of the People's Republic of China (PRC). There are exhibition halls with Chinese artifacts and paintings, computer laboratories equipped with multi-media tools, libraries with Chinese textbooks, references, periodicals and

maps. The Sirindhorn Chinese Language Center is the only one of its kind supported by the Peoples' Republic of China, outside China.

Cosmetic Science

Affiliated with: School of Cosmetic Science, Mae Fah Luang University

Program Emphases:

This program aims to produce graduates who possess knowledge and competency to pursue careers related to cosmetic science. It involves studies and experimentation of naturally-obtained, chemically-synthesised and biotechnologically synthesised materials and substances used in the production of cosmetics. In addition, graduates of this program will be equipped with the expertise to conduct research concerning cosmetic manufacture and cosmetic-quality guarantee, as well as providing counselling for consumers of cosmetics.



Health Care Service

Affiliated with: School of Health Science, Mae Fah Luang University

Program Emphases:

This program aims to produce graduates who possess knowledge, competence and expertise based on basic medical principles to provide medically-proper health care for elderly people, patients with chronic diseases, in-patients, children and enervated or disabled people, in an attempt to revitalize and invigorate the patients. Graduates of this program will also be capable of managing health care services.

Applied Thai Medicine

Affiliated with: School of Health Science, Mae Fah Luang University

Program Emphases:

This program aims to produce graduates who possess knowledge, competence and expertise to practice Thai Medicine in the areas of medical treatment, chiropractic, pharmacology and obstetrics. It also attempts to establish a modern practice of Thai medicine based on scientific knowledge and principles, combined with various non-modern practices of medicine. Because it focuses on science-based treatment, it can be practised along with modern medicine. Graduates of this program will be entitled to take an examination administered by the Ministry of Public Health in order to acquire a medical practitioner's license in medical treatment, chiropractic, pharmacology and obstetrics by the Ministry of Public Health.
